- Sources should be cited using endnotes in the following format:
Last Name, First Initial (Year). Title. *Journal*, Vol#(Issue #), Pages.
(See published issues for clarification.)
- All text, including references, is double-spaced in Arial or Times New Roman font with one-inch margins.
